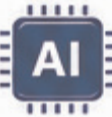

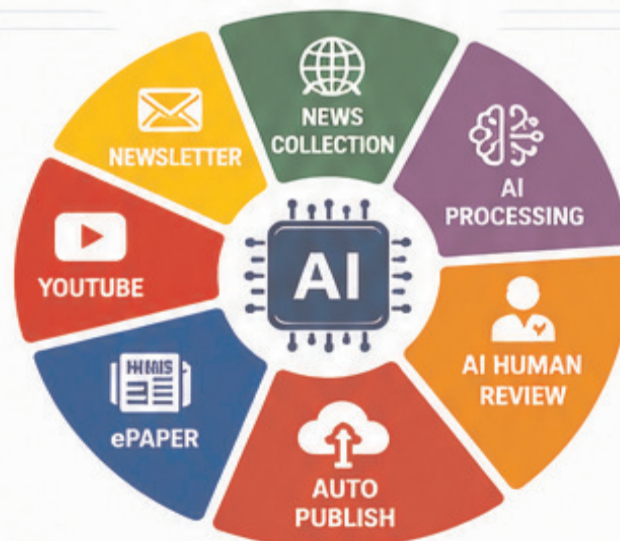

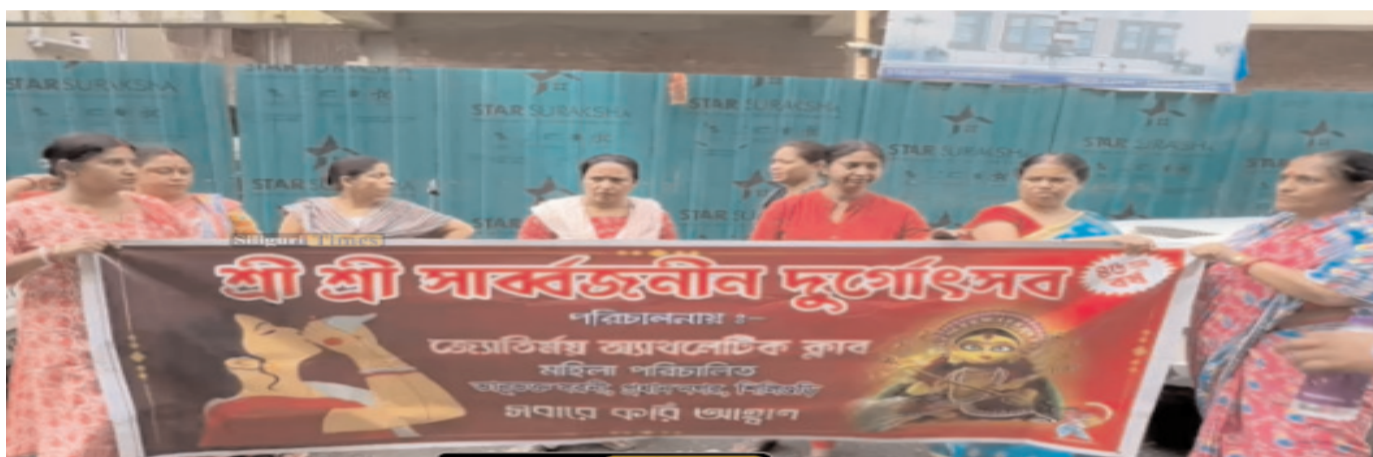

## Uncertainty Over 46-Year-Old Durga Puja in Siliguri as Construction Begins at Traditional Venue

Siliguri | July 9:  
A cloud of uncertainty has emerged over the future of the 46-year-old Durga Puja organised by the women-led Jyotirmoy Athletic Club in Siliguri's Ward No. 02 after construction work commenced on the vacant land that has served as the festival venue for decades. According to the puja committee, the organisers had earlier received assurances from the developer that sufficient space would be reserved for the annual celebration. However, they now claim they have been informed that no space can be provided this year, putting the long-standing



community festival at risk. The committee also alleged that when members began

preparations by installing promotional banners, a complaint was lodged against

eight of its members at the Pradhan Nagar Police Station. The incident has

sparked concern among local residents and festival organisers.

Former councillors Ram Bhajan Mahato and Gargi Chatterjee reportedly held discussions with the developer to resolve the issue. While the committee has raised concerns over the construction and alleged irregularities, Mahato denied all allegations and stated that efforts are underway to ensure the Durga Puja is organised without disruption. Reacting to the controversy, local BJP leaders demanded a fair and impartial investigation, urging the authorities to safeguard the interests of the community and preserve one of the area's oldest Durga Puja celebrations.

### Elderly Woman Found Dead in Siliguri Home; Local Foundation Conducts Last Rites



Siliguri | July 9:  
An elderly woman was found dead inside her residence in the Chayan Para area near Ghogomali Fruit Market, Siliguri, triggering concern among local residents. The deceased has been identified as Biva Biswas. According to local sources, Biva Biswas had been living with her daughter, who is reportedly facing mental health challenges, after the death of her husband several years ago. The incident came to light on Thursday morning when the daughter received no response despite repeatedly calling out to her mother. She then alerted neighbours,

who entered the house and found the elderly woman dead. The body had reportedly begun to decompose. With no immediate family members available to take responsibility, volunteers from the Muktohdara Foundation reached the spot, assisted in recovering the body, and arranged the woman's final rites with dignity. The incident has left residents of the locality deeply saddened and has highlighted the challenges faced by elderly people living in vulnerable circumstances. Authorities are following the necessary legal procedures to determine the exact cause of death.

### Governor R.N. Ravi Reviews Higher Education Challenges at Meeting with Vice-Chancellors in Siliguri

Siliguri | July 9:  
West Bengal Governor R.N. Ravi chaired a high-level meeting with the Vice-Chancellors of 20 state universities at the administrative building of the University of North Bengal (NBU) to review the status of higher education and discuss key institutional challenges. During the meeting, Vice-Chancellors and Registrars highlighted several issues, including infrastructure development, administrative hurdles, faculty shortages, and vacancies in key positions such as Registrars and Finance Officers. They also discussed measures to strengthen academic governance and improve the overall functioning of universities. The Governor urged university heads to focus on organising annual convocation ceremonies, enhancing institutional revenue generation, promoting skill development programmes, and introducing



more certificate courses to improve students' employability. Governor Ravi assured the participants that he would

personally visit universities across the state to better understand their challenges and work towards finding practical solutions. The

meeting reflected a collective effort to strengthen the quality and efficiency of higher education institutions in West Bengal.

### SMC Demolishes Illegal Structure on Panchanai River Embankment During Anti-Encroachment Drive

Siliguri | July 9: The Siliguri Municipal Corporation (SMC) carried out an anti-encroachment drive on Thursday, demolishing a structure allegedly functioning as a TMC party office that had been constructed illegally on the embankment of the Panchanai River in Ward No. 47. Municipal officials, accompanied by a heavy police deployment from Pradhan Nagar



Police Station, conducted the demolition to ensure the operation was completed peacefully and without any untoward incidents. Local resi-

dents welcomed the action, stating that illegal constructions on river embankments pose serious risks to drainage systems, flood management

and the structural safety of the embankment, especially during the monsoon season. The Siliguri Municipal Corporation reiterated its commitment to removing illegal encroachments on government land, river embankments and other public spaces, stating that similar enforcement drives will continue to safeguard public infrastructure and environmental safety.

# BJP Fields Three Former TMC Leaders for Rajya Sabha Bypolls in Major Political Move



Kolkata | July 9: In a significant political development ahead of the Rajya Sabha by-elections in West Bengal, the Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP) has nominated Sushmita Dev, Sukhendu Sekhar Roy and Prakash Chik Barik as its candidates shortly after the three former Trinamool Congress (TMC) leaders formally joined the party. The trio had recently resigned from both the Trinamool Congress and their Rajya Sabha memberships, creating vacancies for the upcoming bypolls scheduled for July 24. Their induction into the BJP and immediate nomination is being viewed as a major political setback for the ruling TMC. Welcoming the leaders, West Bengal BJP President Samik Bhattacharya said the party values experienced leaders with clean public records and expressed confidence that their political experience would strengthen the BJP's position in the state.

After joining the BJP, Sushmita Dev and Sukhendu Sekhar Roy criticised the TMC, raising concerns over alleged corruption and governance issues. The BJP maintained that the new entrants would contribute to expanding the party's organisational strength ahead of key political contests. With the Rajya Sabha by-elections approaching, the BJP's move has intensified the political battle in West Bengal, setting the stage for a closely watched contest between the state's two major political rivals.

### Three Former TMC Rajya Sabha MPs Join BJP Ahead of West Bengal Bypolls

Kolkata | July 9: In a major political development ahead of the Rajya Sabha by-elections, former Trinamool Congress (TMC) Rajya Sabha MPs Sushmita Dev, Sukhendu Sekhar Roy and Prakash Chik Barik formally joined the Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP) in Kolkata on Thursday. The three leaders were welcomed into the party by West Bengal BJP President Samik Bhattacharya, who said their vast political experience would strengthen the BJP's organisational base and expand its influence in the state. The leaders had resigned from both the TMC and the Rajya Sabha last month, leading to vacancies that will be filled in the upcoming by-elections. After joining the BJP, Sushmita Dev praised Prime Minister Narendra Modi's leadership and said the development witnessed in BJP-ruled states reflected the benefits of a "double-engine government." She expressed confidence that West Bengal could witness similar progress under a BJP-led administration. Launching a sharp attack on the ruling TMC, Samik Bhattacharya alleged that the state's development had suffered over the past several decades and asserted that the BJP was emerging as a stronger alternative in West Bengal. The high-profile defections have intensified the political atmosphere in the state ahead of the Rajya Sabha bypolls, with both the BJP and TMC preparing for a closely contested electoral battle.

# TTE Suspended After First AC Coach Decorated as 'Honeymoon Suite' on Nandigram Express



Mumbai | July 9: A unique incident aboard the Nandigram Express has sparked controversy after a newlywed couple decorated a First AC coupe like a honeymoon suite using balloons, flower garlands and rose petals. The viral video of the lavishly decorated cabin prompted swift action from the railway authorities. According to officials, the cabin was adorned with red and white balloons, fresh flowers and jasmine garlands, while rose petals covered the seats and floor. The presence of lighted candles and oil lamps inside the coach raised serious safety concerns, as carrying and using flammable items on trains violates railway safety regulations and poses a significant fire hazard. Following a preliminary inquiry, the on-duty Travelling Ticket Examiner (TTE) was suspended for alleged negligence. The railway administration also initiated action against the agency responsible for arranging the unauthorised decorations. The incident triggered mixed reactions on social media. While some users described the gesture as romantic and creative, many criticised the disregard for passenger safety and questioned how such

decorations were allowed inside a moving train. Railway authorities reiterated that unauthorised decorations and the use of flammable materials inside train coaches are strictly prohibited, warning that strict action will be taken against anyone found violating safety norms.

### Calcutta High Court Grants Interim Relief to TMC in Frozen Bank Accounts Case

Kolkata | July 9: The Calcutta High Court has granted interim relief to the Trinamool Congress (TMC) by allowing the party to use funds from its three frozen bank accounts, which reportedly contain around ₹440 crore, for essential organisational and legal expenses. However, the court clarified that the party will not regain full control over the accounts. To ensure financial transparency, it appointed former Justice Subrata Talukdar as Special Officer, who will supervise all transactions and oversee the operation of the accounts until September 30, 2026. Under the court's directions, funds can be used only for day-to-day administrative expenses, staff salaries, and legal costs. All cheque payments must receive the countersignature of the Special Officer before being processed, while major or capital expenditures remain strictly prohibited. During the hearing, the court questioned the speed with which the bank accounts had been frozen, observing that the action appeared unusually swift at the interim stage. It also clarified that the order is purely temporary and does not determine the dispute over the party's leadership, which remains pending before the Election Commission of India. The matter is scheduled for its next hearing on September 21, 2026.

dence and independent thinking. Experts also stressed that achieving the vision of a developed India by 2047 will require universities to become centres of innovation and entrepreneurship, while nurturing scientifically minded and socially responsible citizens capable of shaping the future through knowledge and discovery.

## PM Modi Highlights Strong India-Australia Partnership with Memorable Messages During Australia Visit

Melbourne | July 10: Prime Minister Narendra Modi delivered a series of impactful messages during his two-day visit to Australia, combining diplomacy with powerful analogies to underline the growing strength of the India-Australia Comprehensive Strategic Partnership. Using cricket as a symbol of the close relationship between the two democracies, Modi remarked that India-Australia diplomacy resembles the sport itself—focused like a One-Day match, swift in decision-making like a T20 game, and built on long-term trust like a Test match. The Prime Minister's speeches, coupled with several strategic agreements in defence, trade, clean energy, technology, education and maritime security, reflected a new phase of deepening cooperation between India and Australia.

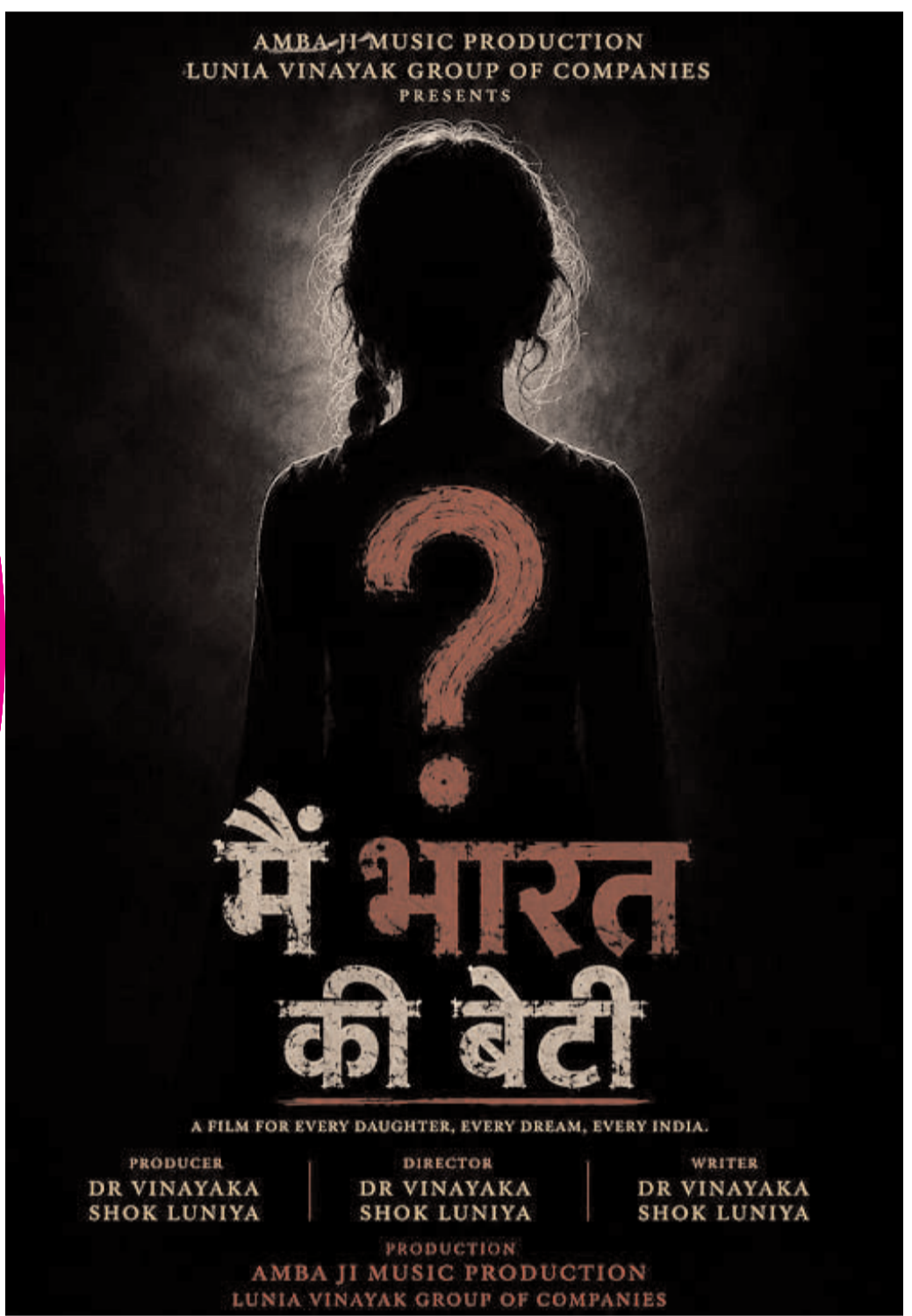

## Renewed U.S. Sanctions on Iran Disrupt India's Oil Import Plans Amid Gulf Tensions



**New Delhi | July 10:** India's energy sector has received a major setback after the United States reimposed stringent sanctions on Iran, effectively ending the temporary relief that had allowed limited crude oil transactions. The decision comes amid escalating tensions in West Asia and has disrupted plans by several Indian oil companies to resume imports of Iranian crude. According to industry sources, some Indian refiners had already initiated procurement procedures, with payments processed and essential banking documents prepared before the renewed sanctions were announced. The sudden policy reversal has forced companies to reassess shipments, explore alternative supply routes and review existing contracts. The renewed restrictions are expected to have a greater impact on Liquefied Petroleum Gas (LPG) and Liquefied Natural Gas (LNG) supplies than on crude oil. While India continues to source crude from countries such as Russia, Saudi Arabia and the UAE, replacing gas imports is considerably more challenging, raising concerns over supply availability and higher import costs. The escalating conflict has also increased risks along the Strait of Hormuz, one of the world's busiest energy shipping routes. Rising freight charges, insurance premiums and logistical uncertainties are likely to push up import costs for energy companies. Meanwhile, global crude oil prices have climbed sharply, with Brent crude nearing \$80 per barrel, reflecting growing concerns over regional instability. Energy analysts warn that prolonged geopolitical tensions could lead to higher fuel prices, increased inflationary pressure and greater challenges for energy-importing nations such as India.

## EPF Scheme 2026: New Rules Bring Greater Flexibility and Simpler Withdrawal Process for Employees

**New Delhi | July 10:** The Employees' Provident Fund Organisation (EPFO) has introduced the EPF Scheme 2026, replacing the previous 1952 framework under the Code on Social Security, 2020. The updated scheme aims to simplify provident fund management while offering greater flexibility for salaried employees. Under the new rules, existing EPF members will not be required to open a new PF account or obtain a new Universal Account Number (UAN). Their existing balance and service history will continue without interruption. The mandatory contribution rate remains 12% each from both the employee and employer, while the statutory wage ceiling continues at ₹15,000 per month. Employees earning above this limit can voluntarily contribute a higher amount to build a larger retirement corpus, with the flexibility to increase, reduce or discontinue such additional contributions based on their financial needs. The scheme also simplifies partial withdrawal provisions, grouping them into broader categories such as medical emergencies, higher education, marriage, housing requirements and special circumstances. Employees leaving their jobs may withdraw up to 75% of their eligible PF balance, while full settlement may require remaining outside EPFO-covered employment for a specified period. In addition, the revised framework strengthens digital services by promoting online claim filing, faster settlements, electronic passbooks and improved services for members covered under private PF trusts. EPFO has also advised members to update their Aadhaar, PAN, bank account details and digital nominations, as revised nomination rules and enhanced KYC requirements have become an important part of the new scheme to ensure smooth claim processing and secure benefits.

## Toyota Files FIR Against YouTuber Over E20 Fuel Claims

**New Delhi, July 10:** Toyota has filed an FIR against Bihar-based YouTuber Manish Kashyap after an investigation found that his vehicle's engine problem was caused by water contamination in the fuel tank, not E20 ethanol-blended petrol, Union Minister Nitin Gadkari said. The controversy began after the YouTuber claimed in a viral video that E20 fuel had damaged his new Toyota vehicle. Following a technical inspection, Toyota reportedly concluded that water mixed with petrol caused the malfunction. The company has since initiated legal action, alleging the spread of false claims. The government reiterated that the E20 fuel programme remains safe for compatible vehicles and continues to support India's goals of reducing crude oil imports and promoting cleaner energy.

## India Expands Global Critical Minerals Network to Strengthen Supply Chains and Reduce Strategic Dependence

**New Delhi, July 10:** India has significantly accelerated its efforts to secure critical minerals and rare earth resources by building a strategic international partnership network spanning nearly 35 countries, reinforcing its long-term vision of strengthening technological, industrial, and energy security. The initiative comes at a time when global competition for critical minerals has intensified due to their indispensable role in manufacturing electric vehicles, semiconductors, renewable energy equipment, defence technologies, telecommunications infrastructure, and advanced electronics. With China currently dominating much of the global processing and refining capacity for rare earth elements, India is actively diversifying its supply sources and building resilient international partnerships. As part of this strategy, India has already signed cooperation agreements with 24 countries, while negotiations with 11 additional nations are reported to be in advanced stages. Strategic partners include the United States, Canada, Australia, the United Kingdom, France, Germany, Italy, Japan, Brazil, Russia, Indonesia, Vietnam, and the Democratic Republic of Congo, among others. A major milestone was achieved during Prime Minister Narendra Modi's recent diplomatic engagements, where India announced plans to invest in critical mineral processing, nickel production, steel manufacturing, and rare earth permanent magnet facilities in Indonesia. The collaboration is expected to strengthen India's access to essential raw materials while creating diversified global supply chains. The government's strategy is backed by the National Critical Mineral Mission (NCMM), launched for the period 2024-25 to 2030-31, which aims to develop India's domestic capabilities in exploration, mining, processing, refining, recycling, and value addition of strategic minerals such as lithium, cobalt, graphite, nickel, and rare earth elements. Beyond securing raw materials, India is also pursuing technology partnerships with leading economies. Cooperation with the United States and the United Kingdom focuses on resilient supply chains, while Germany and Japan are supporting semiconductor manufacturing and mineral exploration. Russia has emerged as a partner in rare earth magnet technology, whereas Australia, Canada, Brazil, Indonesia, and Vietnam are expected to play key roles in supplying critical mineral resources. Experts believe the expanding international network will help India reduce supply risks, improve industrial competitiveness, and support ambitious initiatives such as Make in India, clean energy expansion, advanced manufacturing, electric mobility, and defence modernization. With geopolitical uncertainties increasingly influencing global trade, India's diversified critical minerals strategy is being viewed as a significant step toward enhancing economic resilience and positioning the country as a reliable manufacturing and technology hub in the evolving global supply chain ecosystem.

Balaghat, July 10: A group of selected farmers from Balaghat district departed on a two-day educational exposure visit to Jawaharlal Nehru Agricultural College under the ATMA (Agricultural Technology Management Agency) Project, organised by the Agriculture Department to mark Fisheries Day. The initiative aims to equip farmers with the latest advancements in agriculture

and fisheries through direct interaction with agricultural scientists and subject experts. During the visit, participants will receive training in natural farming, modern cultivation practices, improved seed production, crop management, and innovative agricultural technologies. They will also visit research units and demonstration farms to gain practical knowledge of advanced farming methods.

Agriculture Department officials said such exposure visits encourage farmers to adopt scientific and sustainable farming practices, helping reduce cultivation costs, improve productivity, and increase farm income. Farmers have also been encouraged to implement the knowledge gained during the programme and share modern agricultural practices with fellow farmers across the district.

## Villagers Block Road in Devgaon Over Increased Transport Fares, Demand Fuel Price Relief

Mandla, July 10: Residents of Devgaon village in Madhya Pradesh's Mandla district staged a road blockade on Thursday to protest the recent hike in passenger transport fares, blaming rising fuel prices for the increased financial burden on rural communities. The protest disrupted traffic as villagers demanded immediate government intervention to control the prices of diesel and petrol. They argued that

the sharp increase in transportation costs has severely affected the daily lives of farmers, labourers, students, and low-income families who rely on private vehicles for commuting. While acknowledging that private vehicle operators have been compelled to raise fares due to higher fuel and maintenance costs, the protesters maintained that the root cause of the problem lies in rising inflation and escalating

fuel prices. They urged the government to introduce fuel subsidies or a special relief package to support rural transport services and reduce the burden on passengers. Villagers also called for effective measures to curb inflation and improve affordability, warning that if no concrete action is taken, the protest could expand into a larger district-wide movement in the coming days.

## Mandla Administration Directs Faster Disposal of Pending Forest Rights Claims

Mandla, July 10: The Mandla district administration has directed officials to expedite the disposal of pending claims under the Forest Rights Act (FRA), ensuring timely and transparent benefits for eligible forest-dwelling communities. During a review meeting held at the Assistant Commissioner's office, officials were instructed to examine all pending and newly received claims for the 2026-

27 period on a priority basis. Assistant Commissioner Dr. Arun Shukla emphasized that every application must be verified thoroughly and processed within the prescribed time frame in accordance with legal provisions. The administration also stressed the need for close coordination among Gram Sabhas, Sub-Divisional Level Committees, and the District Level Committee to facilitate document verification and

speedy decision-making. Officials were directed to maintain proper records, regularly monitor progress, and ensure that no negligence delays the delivery of forest rights to eligible beneficiaries. The initiative aims to strengthen the implementation of the Forest Rights Act by ensuring deserving beneficiaries receive legal recognition of their forest land and livelihood rights without unnecessary delays.

## Man Arrested for Creating AI-Generated Fake High Court Hearing Video to Boost Social Media Reach

Singrauli, July 10: Singrauli Police have arrested a 26-year-old man for allegedly creating and circulating an AI-generated fake video of a virtual hearing of the Jabalpur High Court, which contained objectionable and derogatory remarks against the judiciary. According to police, the accused, Amit Kumar Tiwari, a resident of Pipra Jhanpi village, manipulated footage of a High Court video conference using

Artificial Intelligence and shared the fabricated clip on his Facebook and X (formerly Twitter) accounts. Investigators believe the video was created to gain popularity, increase social media engagement, and attract online attention. Authorities stated that the viral video falsely portrayed court proceedings and included offensive comments targeting the judiciary, prompting immediate legal action. Following an investigation,

police arrested the accused and produced him before a local court, which remanded him to judicial custody. Officials reiterated that the creation and circulation of AI-generated fake content targeting constitutional institutions is a serious offence and warned that strict action would be taken against individuals who misuse technology to spread misinformation or damage public trust.

## Mandla Reviews Women and Child Welfare Schemes, Focuses on Nutrition and Transparency

Mandla, July 10: The Women and Child Development Department held a district-level review meeting at the Zila Panchayat auditorium to assess the progress of various welfare schemes and strengthen services for women and children.

District Programme Officer Vinod Paraste directed officials to ensure transparency, timely submission of accurate data, and effective implementation of government programmes. He also instructed supervisors to improve coordination with Anganwadi workers and regu-

larly update the Poshan Tracker application. The meeting emphasized improving nutrition, health, protection, and overall development of women and children while ensuring that welfare benefits reach eligible beneficiaries efficiently and on time.

# Bihar Announces Major Relief for Farmers with Low-Cost Power Supply

The Bihar government has announced a major relief package for farmers by ensuring 12 hours of uninterrupted electricity for agricultural

feeders from 6:00 AM to 6:00 PM. Farmers will continue to receive power at a highly subsidized rate of ₹0.55 per unit, with the state bearing nearly

93% of the cost to reduce irrigation expenses and support agricultural productivity. During a high-level review meeting with Union Minister for New and Renewable Energy Pralhad Joshi, Chief

Minister Samrat Choudhary directed officials to strengthen agricultural power infrastructure and accelerate renewable energy initiatives, including the PM-KUSUM and PM Surya Ghar schemes. The

state also plans to introduce a Green Hydrogen Policy to attract clean energy investments. The meeting further reviewed Bihar's public distribution system, with instructions to

speed up the issuance of one crore new ration cards, improve digital beneficiary records, and strengthen infrastructure at government food storage facilities to ensure efficient food distribution.

## Jharkhand Signs 1 Lakh Crore Investment MoUs; Jindal to Set Up First Nuclear Power Plant

Jharkhand has signed investment proposals worth nearly ₹1 lakh crore with 12 companies, marking a major push for industrial growth, clean energy, technology, and healthcare. The agreements were signed in the presence of Chief Minister Hemant Soren during the National Stakeholders Consultation in Delhi.

A major highlight is the state's first nuclear power plant, which will be established by Jindal Nuclear Power Pvt. Ltd. with an investment of around ₹30,000 crore and a proposed capacity of 1,400 MW. Jindal Steel will also set up a steel plant with an investment of ₹40,000 crore, while other companies including Tata Steel and Ambuja Cement have announced expansion projects.



Google LLC has signed an agreement to provide AI, cloud, and data training support, including AI training for around 2.3 lakh teachers in the state. AI-based healthcare solutions for disease

detection and TB control will also be developed. CM Hemant Soren emphasized long-term development, innovation, and greater participation of tribal communities in industrial growth.

Singapore has also shown interest in investing in Jharkhand, further strengthening the state's global investment prospects.

## Bihar Approves High-Speed RRTS Plan to Transform Regional Connectivity



The Bihar government has approved an ambitious Rapid Regional Transit System (RRTS) project to connect Patna with Gaya, Bhagalpur, Muzaffarpur, and Ara through

high-speed rail services. The state has sanctioned ₹31.59 crore for preparing the Detailed Project Report (DPR) and finalizing the routes. Designed to operate at speeds of up to 160 km/h, the modern trains are expected to significantly reduce travel time. The Patna-Muzaffarpur journey, which currently takes up to three hours by conventional trains, could be completed in just 60 minutes. Inspired by the successful Delhi-Meerut RRTS model, the project aims to improve connectivity, boost economic growth, attract investment, and create new employment opportunities across Bihar.

# Delhi Schools to Make 'Good Touch-Bad Touch' Awareness Classes Mandatory

Delhi Chief Minister Rekha Gupta has announced a major child safety initiative under the POCSO Awareness Month, making 'Good Touch and Bad Touch' awareness sessions mandatory in all schools across the national capital.

Under the new campaign, every school will have to implement a child protection protocol and submit a compliance report within 15 days. The initiative aims to educate children about personal safety, help them identify unsafe



situations, and create a secure learning environment. The campaign will involve cooperation from parents, teachers, Delhi Police, district officials, and Anganwadi workers to strengthen child protection measures. By the end of July, child protection committees will be formed in all 5,633 schools across Delhi.

Teachers and school staff will also receive training on the Protection of Children from Sexual Offences (POCSO) Act to ensure better prevention, awareness, and response mechanisms for child safety concerns.

## Delhi Teacher Attempts Suicide Allegedly Due to Census Duty Pressure; Family Claims Mental Harassment

A government school teacher in Delhi allegedly attempted suicide after facing extreme pressure related to census duty, according to family members. The incident has raised concerns over work-related stress and the mental health challenges faced by government employees. The teacher was first taken to Hindu Rao Hospital and later shifted to St. Stephen's Hospital, where family mem-

bers were informed about the situation. The teacher's brother-in-law, Vikram Singh Tomar, alleged that the victim had been under severe mental stress for the past several days and had repeatedly tried to communicate his difficulties with senior officials. The family claimed that the teacher had submitted medical documents seeking relief from duty, but his requests were allegedly not accepted.

They said he had been expressing concerns about being unable to continue working under the pressure. The teacher, who works at a Sarvodaya Vidyalaya under MCD, lives in Shastri Nagar and has a family comprising his wife, son, and daughter. Authorities are expected to investigate the circumstances surrounding the incident and take necessary action.

## Delhi Jantar Mantar Protest: CJP Founder Abhijeet Deepke Clashes with Police Over Tarpaulin Issue During Heavy Rain

New Delhi: The protest by the Cockroach Janata Party (CJP) at Delhi's Jantar Mantar continued amid heavy rainfall, with protesters facing difficulties due to waterlogging and worsening weather conditions. Students participating in the protest claimed that their mattresses, bedsheets and clothes were soaked due to continuous rain. During the protest, CJP founder Abhijeet Deepke accused Delhi Police officials of preventing protesters from carrying tarpaulins inside the protest area. He argued that the tarpaulins were necessary to protect students, many of whom had been sitting on hunger strike for the past 12 days, from the rain. Heated Argument Between Protesters and Police A heated exchange took place between Abhijeet Deepke and police officials during the protest. Deepke questioned why students were not being allowed to bring rain protection materials inside while heavy rainfall continued. He claimed that several students had fallen ill after remaining exposed to the rain for hours. He also alleged that police officials were saying that permission



could only be granted after receiving instructions from senior authorities. Deepke Questions Police Arrangements Deepke criticized the arrangements at the protest site, saying that while police personnel had access to shelter and protection from the rain, protesting students were struggling without adequate cover. He reportedly questioned why officers' uniforms remained dry while students' clothes and bedding were completely soaked due to the continuous rainfall. Appeal to Police Officials During the argument, Deepke made an emotional appeal to police personnel, saying that most of the

protesting students were between 19 and 20 years old. He urged officials to understand the difficulties faced by the students and consider the situation as they would if their own children were in a similar condition. Protest Continues Despite Rain The protesters have remained firm on their demands and stated that their movement is peaceful. The dispute over allowing tarpaulins inside the protest area has now become a major issue, with protesters demanding basic protection from the ongoing heavy rain. Authorities have not yet issued a detailed statement regarding the allegations made by the protesters.

## Delhi Waterlogging Tragedy: 7-Year-Old Boy Dies After Drowning in Rain-Filled Pit



A tragic incident in Delhi's Samaypur Badli area has raised fresh concerns over waterlogging management during the monsoon. A 7-year-old boy named Rehan died after drowning in a water-filled pit at Sanjay Colony following heavy rainfall.

According to the investigation, Rehan, a Class 3 student, had gone outside to play with his younger brother on Thursday morning. When he did not return home for a long time, his family started searching for him. After nearly two hours, he was found trapped in a rainwater-filled

pit at an empty plot. He was rushed to Burari Hospital, where doctors declared him dead. Police have ruled out any foul play in the initial investigation and termed it an accidental drowning. However, local residents alleged that they had repeatedly complained about water accumulation at the site, but no action was taken, turning the vacant plot into a dangerous spot during the monsoon. Meanwhile, heavy rainfall also caused severe traffic disruptions across Delhi, with major congestion reported on Ring Road, Outer Ring Road, NH-48, Dhaura Kuan, Mahipalpur, Rajokri, Ashram, Mathura Road, Delhi-Gurugram Expressway, and several other key routes.

## Maharashtra Politics: Sunetra Pawar Meets Devendra Fadnavis, Political Speculations Intensify After Sharad Pawar-Eknath Shinde Meeting

Mumbai: Political activities in Maharashtra have once again gained momentum after a series of high-profile meetings among senior leaders. After the meeting between Sharad Pawar and Eknath Shinde at the Vidhan Bhavan, another significant meeting took place when Deputy Chief Minister Sunetra Pawar met Chief Minister Devendra Fadnavis in Mumbai.

According to sources in the Nationalist Congress Party (NCP), Sunetra Pawar discussed the party's position with Fadnavis and conveyed its stand regarding possible political developments, including discussions around a merger between NCP factions and future alliance possibilities with the National Democratic Alliance (NDA). Sources also claimed that Fadnavis assured her that any major political decision would be taken only after keeping all stakeholders informed. However, Fadnavis has earlier stated that there is currently no vacancy for



another alliance partner in the NDA. Political Speculations Rise in Maharashtra Although the meetings are being described as courtesy visits, their timing and sequence have triggered intense discussions in political circles. Opposition leaders have reacted sharply to

Sharad Pawar's meeting with Eknath Shinde. Shiv Sena (UBT) leader Sanjay Raut criticized the meeting, saying that meeting at the office of those responsible for bringing down the previous government sends the wrong political message. He maintained that Sharad Pawar is a respected senior

leader but questioned the political significance of such interactions. Former Maharashtra Chief Minister and Congress leader Prithviraj Chavan claimed that around five to six MPs from the Sharad Pawar faction may be uncomfortable with the current situation, raising speculation about

possible internal differences within the party. Merger of NCP Factions or Possible NDA Move? The recent political meetings have revived discussions about a possible merger between the two NCP factions. Political sources suggest that the proposal of the Sharad Pawar faction merging with Congress has not received the expected response, leading to speculation about alternative political strategies. Some reports claim that certain leaders from the Sharad Pawar faction are exploring possibilities of joining the ruling alliance. However, leaders from the Sharad Pawar camp have strongly rejected these claims and termed them baseless rumours. NCP leader Rohit Pawar clarified that discussions about joining the NDA are completely unfounded and there is no such proposal under consideration. Sanjay Raut Questions Meeting With Shinde Reacting to Sharad Pawar's

meeting at Eknath Shinde's office, Sanjay Raut said that such a move was inappropriate given the political history between the two groups. He added that he still believes Sharad Pawar will not join the NDA and has confidence in his political ideology. Possibility of Split in Sharad Pawar Faction? Prithviraj Chavan's statement about possible dissatisfaction among Sharad Pawar faction MPs has further intensified political discussions in Maharashtra. After previous developments involving Shiv Sena factions, speculation about another political realignment has increased. However, no official confirmation has come from Sharad Pawar or senior NCP leaders regarding any merger or alliance change. The political situation in Maharashtra remains closely watched as leaders continue their meetings and discussions.

## Maharashtra Politics: Sharad Pawar's Meeting with Eknath Shinde Triggers Sanjay Raut's Anger, Uddhav Sena Raises Questions

Mumbai: A fresh political controversy has erupted in Maharashtra after NCP (Sharad Pawar faction) chief Sharad Pawar decided to hold a party meeting at Deputy Chief Minister Eknath Shinde's chamber in the Vidhan Bhavan. The move has created tension within the Maha Vikas Aghadi (MVA), with Shiv Sena (UBT) leader Sanjay Raut strongly criticizing the decision. Raut accused senior leaders of giving political recognition and respect to those who, according to him, were responsible for breaking the previous government. He questioned why Sharad Pawar chose Eknath Shinde's office for the meeting. Sanjay Raut Criticizes Sharad Pawar's Decision While acknowledging Sharad Pawar's stature as a senior and respected political leader, Sanjay Raut said that

holding a party meeting at the office of Eknath Shinde sends a wrong political message. Raut said, "Sharad Pawar is a respected leader, but choosing the office of the person who brought down our government affects the credibility of such a senior leader." He questioned whether there was no other place available in the Vidhan Bhavan for the meeting and referred to other possible venues associated with Sharad Pawar. 'We Will Never Hold Meetings in a Rebel Leader's Office' Taking a sharp dig at Sharad Pawar's political approach, Raut said that Shiv Sena (UBT) would never hold its party meetings at the office of a leader who, according to them, betrayed the party. He stated that political principles and loyalty matter and alleged that such compromises



es could affect the public image of political parties. Questions Raised Over MVA Coordination Raut claimed that several alliance partners were unhappy with the development. He said that if Shiv Sena (UBT) were in a similar position,

they would never have conducted meetings at the office of leaders who had broken away from their party. He also questioned the outcome of a high-level meeting held at Vidhan Bhavan regarding the Maharashtra-Karnataka border dispute,

asking what decisions were taken and when the next discussion would take place. 'Sharad Pawar Is Giving Respect to Rebels' Sanjay Raut alleged that by meeting Eknath Shinde and using his office, Sharad Pawar was indirectly giving





legitimacy to political rebels. He questioned why action was taken against Ajit Pawar's faction earlier while meetings with the Shinde faction were now taking place. Raut Clarifies His Remarks Are Political, Not Personal Sanjay Raut clarified that his criticism was purely political and not personal. He said that he shares a close relationship with Sharad Pawar but would continue to maintain his party's stand on political matters. He added that Shiv Sena (UBT) would continue opposing those who, according to the party, weakened the previous political alliance. The controversy has added another layer to Maharashtra's already active political landscape, with alliance dynamics and leadership meetings being closely watched across the state.
